

Bed Bug Treatment INSTRUCTIONS FOR CUSTOMERS



BEFORE PROFESSIONAL TREATMENT

TEXTILES

- Place bed linens, bedding from wardrobes and storage spaces under the bed, clothes from wardrobes (if the wardrobe is near the infested bed/sofa), and curtains from the infested room into a plastic bag.
- Leave the plastic bags in the room until the ADERA technician arrives.
- Items sensitive to high temperatures and washing must be frozen, placed in a tumble dryer, or sprayed during treatment.

METICULOUS CLEANUP

- Dust, sweep, and mop the affected area.
 Cleaning will increase the product's effectiveness.
- Vacuum everything and destroy the vacuum bag.
- Wash the vacuum hose carefully in water warmer than 60 °C, letting the water run through it for at least 5 minutes.

FURNITURE

 Don't handle or move the furniture into other rooms.

ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES

 Unplug all appliances from electical outlets.

ITEMS AND FOOD

- Do not remove any objects from the room and consult an ADERA technician about the possibilities of their treatment (e.g. in a freezer at -5 °C for two days or until completely frozen through, or by ironing).
- Remove items such as pictures and mirrors from the walls and leave them in the room.
- Put away or cover food, herbs, toys and valuable items.
- If you have an aquarium in your flat, switch off the aerator and cover it.



Before treatment itself, you will need to leave the flat along with any pets!

FOLLOWING PROFESSIONAL TREATMENT

RETURNING TO THE FLAT

- You can return to your flat after the protective period (at least 8 hours for people and 12 hours for pets).
- You can return to the flat once the insecticide has completely dried.

CLEANUP

- Do not wash the treated surfaces (only wash surfaces that may come into contact with food). Do not vacuum carpets and upholstered furniture. Only vacuum floors without carpets. Follow these instructions until the next ADERA treatment.
- Following the first treatment, wash the bed linen, clothing, and other textiles on the highest possible temperature (at least 60 °C).

OCCURRENCE OF BED BUGS FOLLOWING TREATMENT

- It is quite common to encounter live bed bugs for the first few days to weeks after the treatment.
- The insecticides may not immediately reach all the bed bugs – they will come into contact with the insecticides in the following days.
- No insecticide kills eggs it only kills the hatched bed bugs.

SLEEPING IN BED

- After the protective period, you can sleep in the bed again.
- It's very important that you keep using the rooms where the bed bugs are as you normally would.
- Put clean bed linens on the bed (do not sleep in the bed without bed linens).

RECOMMENDATION AFTER TREATMENT

- Do not move furniture in the flat and do not bring in new furniture.
- Store items thermally treated after the first treatment at a sufficient distance from the infested bed/furniture.
- Wash bed linens 1× per week (at at least 60 °C).



One treatment will never kill all the bed bugs, the insecticide must be re-applied in 3-4 weeks.

PRODUCT SAFETY

	Follow instructions and	observe the	protective i	period in order	to ensure	product safety.

- Product may leave temporary marks on furniture or the floor, but these do not usually cause any long-term damage.
- Once the pests are eradicated, the marks can be easily wiped away. **Never wipe product off**before the bed bugs are eradicated or before the recommendation of the ADERA technician.
